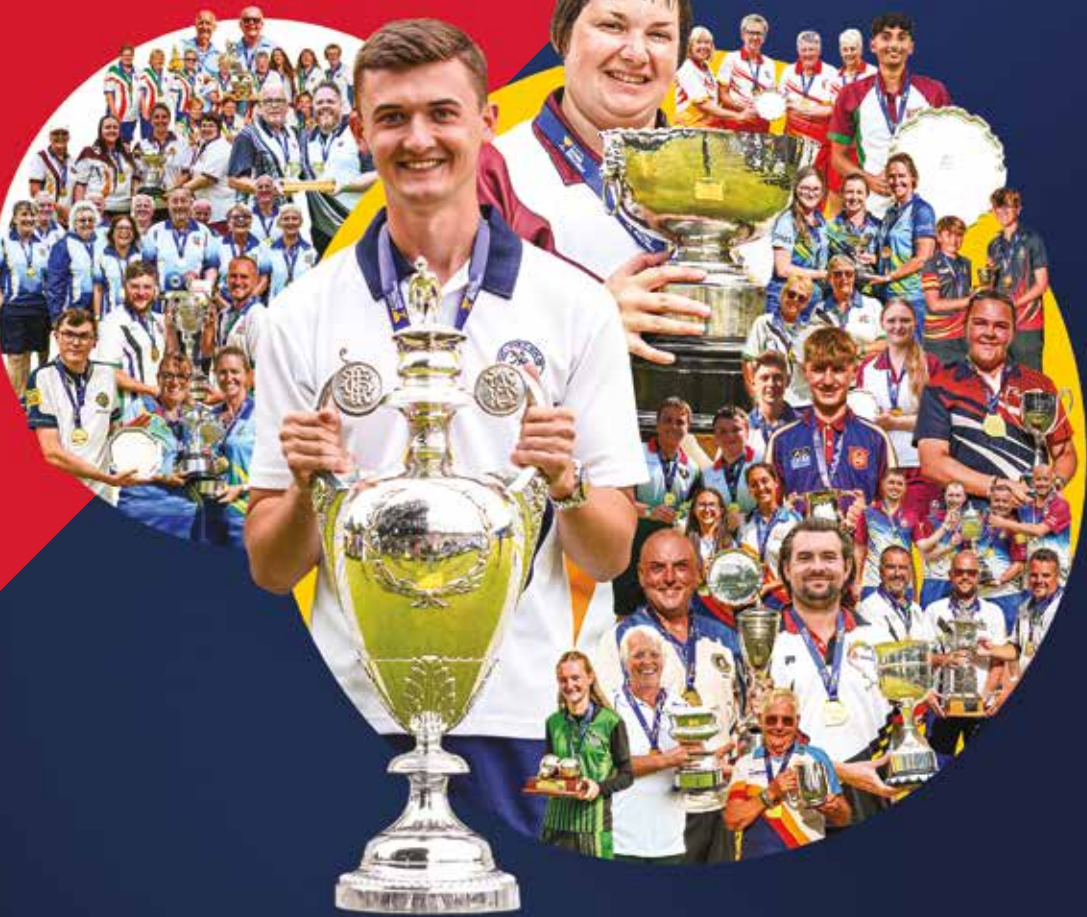

FESTIVAL ACCESSIBILITY

Art in the Park is a free community festival held in the beautiful heart of Leamington Spa, and we're committed to making it an inclusive and welcoming space for everyone.

All of our parks are wheelchair accessible, with accessible toilets located in Jephson gardens, and an additional accessible portaloos in Mill Gardens.

For visitors with SEND needs, we've created a quiet space to retreat to if you need a moment of calm. Keep an eye out for the SEND symbol  throughout the festival - it highlights areas

specifically designed with neurodivergent and sensory needs in mind.

Please note: While there are paved paths throughout the park, exhibitor stands and music stages are located on grass. If you require assistance navigating to these areas, visit our Information Tent next to the Clock Tower, or speak to one of our friendly team members in high-visibility vests - they'll be more than happy to help.

Lost child wristbands are available at all entrance gates - please ask one of our volunteers if you'd like one for your child.



British Sign Language (BSL) interpreters will be present on both music stages, ensuring

all musical performances are accessible to our Deaf and hard-of-hearing visitors.

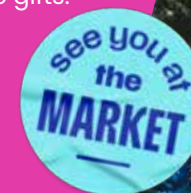

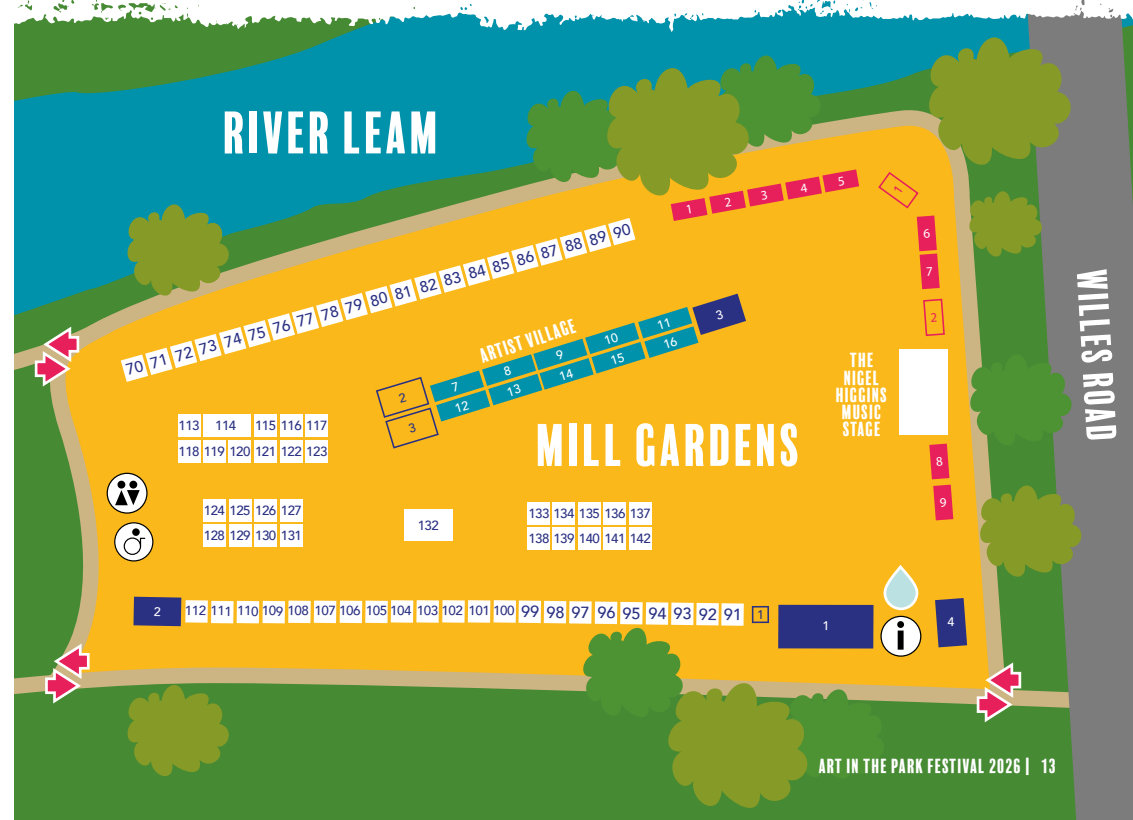

THE MYTON HOSPICES

At The Myton Hospices we believe that everyone matters for every single moment of their life; we focus on enhancing life when cure is no longer an option.

We are not just about end of life care, we are here to support patients and their loved ones right from the moment they are diagnosed.

We have three hospices, and have the only Hospice Inpatient beds in Coventry and Warwickshire. We care

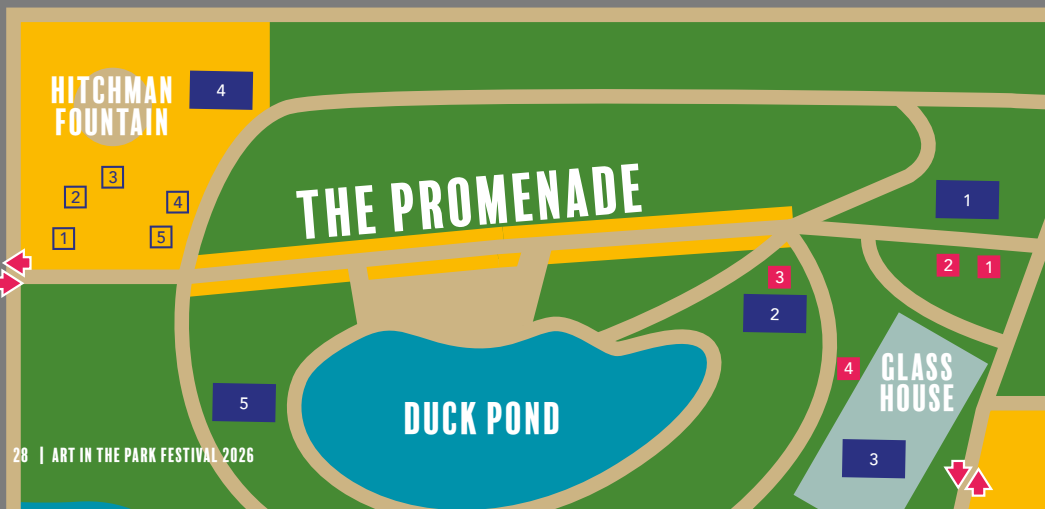
